## Minutes of the Council meeting of the Merseyside Quiz Leagues held at Old Swan Conservative Club on Sunday 12th June 2011 at 8:00 pm

- **2. Minutes of previous meeting:** The previous minutes having been circulated were accepted as a true and fair record.
- 3. **Matters Arising:** There were no matters arising.
- **4.** Chairman's report: The Chairman reported on a good and well attended Presentation Night.
- **5. General Secretary's report:** The Gen Sec reported on the outcome of the finals from the two end of season events and also on the North v South match which had taken place the previous day in London, unfortunately it had not been a fruitful journey.
